# Proclaiming the Gospel

## In 2015:

Over **3,000** new followers of Jesus were baptized through our **220** indigenous church planters in **eight** countries.

**140** churches and house church gatherings were planted by our Asian partners.

Over **1,700** pastors and lay leaders were trained through conferences and condensed seminary courses conducted by our Asian partners.

**730** church planters received ministry tools, including Bibles, hymn books, teaching materials, and motorbikes for faster and safer travel to ministry sites.

**Seven** Christians were helped with medical, legal and/or relocation assistance following severe persecution.

# Demonstrating the Gospel

## In 2015:

Over **400** children participated in HB-sponsored afterschool tutoring programs.

More than **1,000** children were enrolled in school, including **600** in schools operated by our partners.

**15** low-income individuals were employed through social enterprises started by our partners, including granite brush and sanitary pad manufacturing businesses.

Over **100** people from oppressed & marginalized groups received job training in marketable fields.

More than **9,000** benefited from relief and development programs, including flood and earthquake relief, hygiene and sanitation education, and disaster preparedness training.
