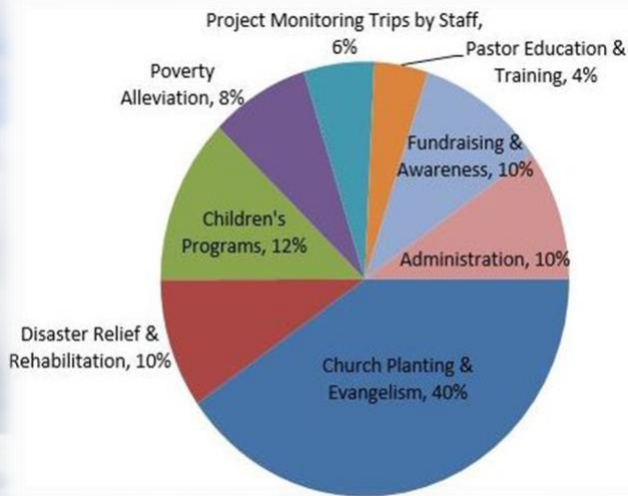


Financial Report

Budgets include HB-facilitated grants, which are sent from grantors directly to our Asian partner ministries but rely on HB's guidance in project planning, implementation and reporting.

Gospel Proclamation

In 2018:

Over 2,900 new Christians were baptized through our 274 local missionaries in **eight** countries: Bangladesh, Bhutan, India & the Andaman Islands, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, and Tibet.

30 churches, 150 house churches, and 419 small group fellowships were established and grown through our Asian partners' ministries.

More than 800 Christian leaders received ministry training through our Asian partners' efforts.

56 missionaries received ministry tools to enhance their outreach, such as Christian counseling resources, bicycles, and more.

Over 2,000 Bibles were distributed in hard-to-reach areas.

Gospel Demonstration

In 2018:

More than 500 children were educated in schools operated by our Asian partners, and over 1,560 children received after-school tutoring.

65 children from poor families received monthly sponsorships.

21 Christians were given aid after suffering persecution for their faith.

Through our Asian partners' efforts in alleviating poverty, over 420 extremely poor individuals received vocational training, while 54 started businesses, expanded them, or secured better employment.

Over 1,550 people benefited from relief and development programs, including flood relief, hygiene and sanitation education, clean water wells, and free medical care.
