01 Friday. Myanmar (Burma)

Two of our 27 monthly supported pastors are currently in the hospital for Covid-19. More are sick. One of our pastors died in August, and on September 27<sup>th</sup> the wife of one of our pastors also passed away from the virus. Pray for healing & protection.

**02** Sat. India - Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti

Pray for safety from the spread of the virus as people gather to celebrate Gandhi's birthday.

03 Sun. Bhutan

**04** Mon. **Sri Lanka** 

"We were in lockdown from 20th August to October 1st. Churches are not functioning and we gather our believers on phone for prayers to encourage them to be firm in their spiritual life. Pray for us." ~ Ashal\*

10 Sun. South Asia - World Mental Health Day

11 Mon. South Asia - International Day of the Girl

As we recognize the oppression girls face in South Asia + Myanmar & celebrate their strength, praise God for followers of Jesus championing girls.

**12** Tues. **Bangladesh** 

Pray for additional support for our Bangladesh team as costs remain higher because of inflation.

13 Wed. South Asia - Durga Puja

As Hindus continue to celebrate a ten-day celebration of their goddess Durga, pray for soft hearts to the Gospel and boldness from followers of Jesus to speak truth.

14 Thurs. Myanmar (Burma)

"Nowadays we are very much careful whenever we give help because the present [Junta] leaders are not happy with it; they want many people to suffer and lose life, so that [the Junta] can be the only helper and protectors. That's why if they know the people who have helped others the Junta arrest them or cause problems. So, this is one prayer, that God will help us to get freedom as soon as possible. If not, we will be again under their control which we have suffered for many years in the past." ~ Pastor Thang\*

**15** Fri. **South Asia - International Day of Rural Women**Praise God for rural women in South Asia. Most of

our female missionaries are from rural areas. They understand the challenges their fellow women face in general, and the challenges they face because of following Christ. Pray for them as they boldly proclaim Jesus in their communities.
