01 Sunday · Women's Empowerment

Pray for widows who feel unseen.

"A 50-year-old widow was left to raise her two children alone after her husband died. Her community called her cursed, and even her own relatives abandoned her. She had to leave her village. When I met her through our widow support group, she was silent. We began visiting her and shared God's special love for the oppressed. During one of our prayer times, she looked up and said she felt seen after a long time. Slowly, her heart began to heal. We have seen a great transformation in her life." Nima*, F43, Nepal

02 Monday · Myanmar Peasant's Day

Meant to honor the contribution of agriculture and farming in Myanmar, this holiday ironically shares a date with the 1962 military coup. Pray for farmers, aka "peasants", as they bear long-term repercussions of conflict.

03 Tuesday · Bhutan

"Praise God for the generous provision of Bibles. We have distributed them to church members, to youth and children, and to newcomers attending our church. Your support has helped us spread God's Word more effectively and touched many lives." Dawa*, 57F

04 Wednesday · Holi Festival

Pray for a safe and joyful holiday as about 1.5 billion people celebrate the coming of Spring.

05 Thursday · Nepal

Pray for free, safe, and fair elections as the country votes, following the Gen Z protests over rampant governmental corruption last September.

06 Friday · Women's Empowerment

Pray for female leaders who face persecution.

12 Thursday · Women's Empowerment

Praise God for women's economic empowerment programs!

"As a result of earning more money, the women are able to take better care of their families. Their families are eating three meals a day, with good nutrition. They are also getting more respect from their husbands, and are ready to send their children to the public schools, with their own money. In addition, the women who participated in this project are coming forward to help other women in the community." Priya*, F46, India

13 Friday · Nepal-Tibet Border

"Pray that I can reach more women and provide them proper guidance to learn about Jesus, and to help those who are in a difficult situation like abuse, violence and pressure from family." Juhi*, F34

15 Sunday · Women’s Empowerment
Pray for women who are escaping abuse.

“Pooja* is a single mother who escaped from a very abusive marriage. She came to our meetings, and slowly I saw a change in her. Her face became brighter, her words more hopeful. She decided to give her life to Jesus. Now, she’s working a simple job and raising her children in peace. “Please pray for the Gospel music ministries, that God will touch many souls.” Shoipa*, 28F

17 Tuesday · Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Birthday
As the country celebrates the father of their nation, pray for Bangladesh’s future as they continue to struggle with political and social upheaval.

18 Wednesday · Bangladesh
“Pray so that I can provide some good food and medicine to the underprivileged people with whom I share the gospel.” Raba*, F56

19 Thursday · Nepal
“Pray for the youth, that their faith would grow strong, and that God would provide us the resources we need to continue our youth programs and reach more places.” Shoipa*, F32

Pray for more funding of water wells, as many of our leaders work to meet the crucial need of clean water in their communities.

23 Monday · Women’s Empowerment
Pray for the ministry leaders who are rescuing women and children from trafficking in Dhaka, Bangladesh. They provide counseling, medical treatment, housing, and the opportunity for a new start.

24 Tuesday · India, GATE
“Pray that we can teach more classes for the women. They are asking for a job training program.” Priya*, F46

25 Wednesday · Bhutan
Continue to pray for Sister Lhamu*, a missionary in Bhutan, who lost her two-year-old son and her father, Pastor Pema*, in November.

26 Thursday · Bangladesh Independence Day
As they celebrate their independence from Pakistan, pray for the country, which is going through a time of extreme political change.



27 Friday · Myanmar Armed Forces Day
On this day meant to celebrate the Tatmadaw—the country’s military— pray for the safety of citizens from the Tatmadaw itself. Pray for the safety and courage of soldiers who choose to desert the military.

Praise God for women’s health clinics, and the recent provision of menstrual health education and kits to 500 girls in rural Nepal!

“The women come with pain, but they have a big smile when they get treatment, medicine, or surgery. At every medical camp, at least one woman is saved from cancer. In the beginning of the medical camp, I say, ‘We want to serve you in Jesus’ name.’ It’s a living testimony.” Jandi* (Nepal co-director)

As Holy Week begins, pray for the Church around the world to bear witness to Christ’s humble and life-giving love.

30 Monday · Nepal
“Please pray for our ministry serving children with special needs and disabilities, especially autistic children who are often overlooked or neglected in our society.” Geeti*, F47

31 Tuesday · Bhutan
Thank God for answered prayer! “Getting citizenship was my biggest prayer for years. Living in my country without being recognized as a citizen made life very hard for me and my children. I followed up for 30 years. It felt like they were trying to make me give up and stop believing. But God changed the officer’s heart. I failed the speaking test twice but I didn’t give up.
