01 Monday · India
Praise God for more Gypsy and Tribal people receiving land rights these past two months due to Priya's* advocacy!

02 Tuesday · Nepal
“In the next six months, we pray to God that we can bring more people in Christ. We plan to share the gospel to more than 50 Sherpa people.” Namgel*, M40

03 Wednesday · Bhutan
Praise God for a ministry leader training for 140 people that took place last month, with your support!

04 Thursday · Children's Ministry, International Day of Innocent Children Victims of Aggression
Pray for teenagers being targeted by the junta in Myanmar for forced conscription into the military.

The boys are often pushed to the front lines, and the girls are often prostituted. Praise God that we have been able to help 43 young adults and teens escape so far this year. “I saw the smiling faces of the poor parents when they received help from us, and they say thank you to us with tears. 06 Saturday · Children's Ministry

271 children were rescued from human trafficking in Bangladesh. 300 children of persecuted pastors received Christmas gifts in Bhutan. 775 children received tutoring in India. 435 children attended VBS programs in the Andaman Islands. 16 teens were helped to escape kidnapping and conscription by the military in Myanmar. 523 menstrual kits were distributed to girls in Nepal. And more!

07 Sunday · Myanmar
Pray for continued safety: “During the past months, God has been very good to my family and me. Although the area around us was filled with fear and danger and many people were arrested by the authorities and others were injured in accidents, the Lord protected us.” Khin*, M69

08 Monday · Bangladesh
Pray for new believers: “During the past months, when I shared the Gospel with people, 25 individuals decided to confess their faith in Jesus, but due to the family and social pressures, some backed away in fear of persecution.” Sohel*

09 Tuesday · Nepal-Tibet Border
“Three pastors were caught by police in this time. Pray for them.” Aastha*, F39

10 Wednesday · Bhutan
“My goal for God's Kingdom in the next six months is to focus in [a certain] village where [a particular] tribe dwells, who we usually find a bit pious and to be devoted Buddhists. This village has a good number of people, and I have met my friend who will be the person of peace there.” Tandin*, M49

11 Thursday · Myanmar
Pray for the country, as international aid cuts have made it nearly impossible for local journalists to operate. As violence grows, even less of it is being reported on, allowing the junta to act with greater impunity.

12 Friday · Children's Ministry, World Day Against Child Labour
An estimated 160 million children are still engaged in child labour—nearly one in ten children worldwide.

Pray as our leaders address the root causes of child labour: poverty, lack of educational opportunity, violence, natural disasters, and many other issues.



13 Saturday · India, Punjab
