01 **Wednesday · Summer Match, Individuals of HB**
Pray for brother Badri* in India. Summer Match funds support leaders like him, serving under persecution:

“Our ministry has been active in the high mountain villages along the Nepal-Tibet border, a challenging and sensitive region. Our work has focused on sharing the Gospel and building up believers. We organized monthly evangelistic outreaches, though we had to pause a few times due to heavy snowstorms that blocked the mountain paths. During these events, we connected with local families, shared the message of Jesus, and encouraged them with stories of God’s power. We also held weekly house fellowships, which provided a safe and close-knit environment for believers to study the Bible, pray, and support one another.”

I usually stand at bus stands and train stations, rotating my destinations every day to avoid attention and risks. I have identified almost 40 such cases over the past six months. This job has a lot of threats involved, but I still do it because many women are being saved through my work.”
