01 Tuesday · Causes of Persecution, India

Religious nationalism of any kind leads to the marginalization of minority religions in a country.

In India, anti-conversion laws are being used to intimidate Christians. “Now the government brought an anti-Christian bill, and we are not able to openly conduct Sunday worship regularly,” shared Biju*, M32, in a western state. Recently, in that state, two of our pastors were imprisoned and, praise God, later released. Pray for courage, protection, and strength to continue.



02 Wednesday · Bangladesh

Give thanks for two new house churches and for Pastor Protik’s* desire to see “new leaders grow to serve the new believers.”

03 Thursday · Myanmar

Praise God for the healing of many children in Pastor Pan’s* children’s home who were recently hospitalized for dengue fever. Praise God for the protection provided by the dengue vaccine.

04 Friday · India

“We need a church building, which is very important for our believers. Pray for provision of a two-wheeler so that we can more effectively reach remote ministry areas.” Jude*, M43

05 Saturday · International Day of Charity

Pray for local churches and Christian leaders who serve people in poverty and crisis, often with very limited resources. May their practical care meet urgent needs and faithfully reflect the love of Christ.

06 Sunday · Bhutan

“Please pray for our monthly financial support and for the rent of our church in [a certain town].” Chosui*, M50 | Pray also for his wife, who has been repeatedly ill, and for safety as he travels through remote areas.

07 Monday · Causes of Persecution, Bangladesh

Sexism is often a driver of persecution. Pray for the women who persist.

“One day, while traveling on a bus, I tried to engage in a conversation about the Word with a woman. Some people became angry and said that women should not speak so much. A few even tried to force me off the bus, but because of the intervention of others, I didn’t have to get off. A similar incident had happened before, when some Muslim religious leaders had forced me to get off the bus. Even after such experiences, I have not stopped sharing the Gospel on buses, and I will not stop. I am not afraid of being insulted or even dying while working for God, because the Lord gave His life for me. I believe that my Savior is watching over me and guiding me. I want to continue glorifying God throughout my life.” Raba*, F56

08 Tuesday · International Literacy Day

Pray for ministries where learning opens doors for dignity and the Gospel. In Jude’s* ministry in India, women’s fellowships in six locations are helping women grow in faith and learn literacy skills, while Sunday school in ten locations reaches children and their families.

09 Wednesday · Nepal

“I ask for prayer for God’s protection and guidance over my life, and for my family to remain safe, strong, and supported.” Adit*, M38 | Give thanks for a young shepherd who came to understand God’s unconditional love.

10 Thursday · India

Join us in thanking God for four new house churches and growing ministries among women, children, youth, and new disciples. “We need ten Bibles. Our church also needs four carpets, a dholak, and four fans.” Daivi*, F31



11 Friday · Bhutan

Give thanks that a man suffering from a severe asthma attack recovered after believers prayed for him in Gabriel’s ministry.

12 Saturday · Nepal-Tibet

“Pray for my family, my daughter’s education, safety during my travels, and for the people I bring to the Lord.” Amrita*, F45

13 Sunday • Causes of Persecution, Nepal-Tibet

As the Chinese government commits cultural genocide, the lives of Tibetans are strongly controlled. The strict rules they live under, regardless of faith, also impacts how churches operate in the region.

Ratul's* prayer is, "for the situation of people living in Tibet, for the unnecessary prohibitions and oppressions that we have to go through on a daily basis. In the past six months, I faced many restrictions and the border closures limited me to just two evangelistic outreaches." Pray for our leaders, as despite frequent border closures, they continue weekly house fellowships "with caution," providing a safe place for believers to study the Bible, pray, and support one another.

14 Monday • Nepal

"Please pray for economic stability in my family. Pray also for proper infrastructure." Chimini*, M53

15 Tuesday • International Day of Democracy

Pray for governments to lead with justice, protect religious freedom, and create safe communities for people of every faith.

16 Wednesday • India

Praise God for a man in Pastor Caleb's* ministry who experienced healing after years of severe headaches and is now preparing for baptism with his family.

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17 Thursday • Bhutan

"Please pray for good health as I am suffering from spondylosis. My wife is not well; pray for her good health. Please also pray for my son to find a suitable life partner and a job in Bhutan." Ashwin*, M68

18 Friday • Nepal

"I have a dream to do ministry among Tibetan people. Pray for the conversion of the Sherpa people. Three pastors were caught by police; pray for them." Aastha*, F38

19 Saturday • Causes of Persecution, Myanmar

Ethnic tribalism often fuels persecution.

Recently, Pastor Pan shared, "Four Palong individuals were saved through Pastor Lian* and were baptized by him. They began to attend the church and their parents came to know. Then, the problem started. The parents got angry with Lian and they tried to hurt him." Pastor Lian was forced to flee the area. Praise God we were able to help him relocate until the situation quiets down. Pray that God will provide safe travel, shelter, and protection for him. Pray for the four new believers who have been outcast from their families and are now living with fellow church members.

20 Sunday • Bangladesh

"Recently, a devastating fire broke out in [a nearby] slum, leaving thousands of families homeless and without belongings. It was heartbreaking to witness their suffering. I pray for those who lost everything, asking God to restore their hope and provide for their needs." Martha*, F55

21 Monday • International Day of Peace

Pray for families in Myanmar living with war, displacement, and forced conscription. Many parents are selling property or sending young people away in search of safety, while others flee within the country. Pray for protection, wisdom, safe refuge, and a just peace.

22 Tuesday • India

"Please pray for my good health. I am diabetic and trusting God for a miraculous healing." Deepak*, M49

23 Wednesday • Bangladesh

"Pray so that during the monsoon season, when there will be flooding, we can reach out to the affected people with loving hearts and necessary relief." Anoj*, M34

24 Thursday • Nepal-Tibet

"My main prayer request is for my family and for my safety during travels, and for the people I bring to the Lord through the Gospel." Gyan*, M51

25 Friday • Causes of Persecution, Nepal

Political change often leads to increased pressure on Christians.

In the case of Nepal's new government, which was elected with a mandate to root out corruption and misuse of funds within the country, Christians, as a minority, have sometimes become a scapegoat. Pray for pastors, for their families and churches, and for Christians throughout Nepal facing increasing legal and political pressure. Pray that the government course corrects and embraces pluralism.



26 Saturday • Bangladesh

Give thanks with us for seven new house churches, 55 people who professed faith, and opposition that peacefully backed down. "Please pray for the divine protection and safety of the missionaries, as outreach activities are becoming less welcome in many areas." Bijay*, M40

27 Sunday • Andaman Islands

"Pray for the salvation of the Bengali and Ranchi people residing in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, and for unity among all pastors." James*, M54

28 Monday • Myanmar

"Pray for the refugee families and their great needs. Pray for the coup to end soon, for revival among the different tribal peoples, and for reunion with the church members who were forced to flee." Kyi*, M55

29 Tuesday • Andaman Islands

Pray for those in Pastor Kalpesh's* ministry who receive practical help but do not yet attend church regularly. The churches are fasting and praying for spiritual freedom in their communities.

30 Wednesday • International Translation Day

Give thanks for those who translate Scripture, Christian teaching, reports, and stories across languages and cultures. Pray for accurate and faithful translation, and that people everywhere would have access to God's Word in the language of their hearts.
